EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

All entries must be registered with a recognised Stud Society, beef or dual purpose, and a copy of your registration must accompany your entry forms. To enter your livestock you are required to complete and submit TWO FORMS, as well as submit a copy of your registration certificate: For entry to be valid you will need:

1. **Livestock Entry form**
2. **Waiver, Release and Acknowledgement form**
3. **A copy of your Registration Certificate**

ENTRY RULES: See also General Rules & Regulations within this Showbook or online.

1. All entries and payments to be received by Friday 18 May 2018 (Entry forms and Waivers supplied within this Showbook in the "Forms" section form part of your entry. Forms also available from: www.malenysociety.org.au)
2. No exhibitors will be permitted to the grounds unless thoroughly tractable. Stewards have discretionary powers to withdraw an exhibit felt to be not well controlled.
3. All bulls over 12 months must be led with a nose ring lead/grip. No exceptions.
4. Determination of age will be based on age as at 1st May 2018.
5. All winning exhibits must be led in the Grand Parade. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
6. There will be **NO** on-ground dipping facilities available.
7. All persons causing a nuisance by loud comments of the decision of the Judges or otherwise unseemly behaviour will, after being cautioned, be expelled from the Showgrounds and in the case of exhibitors, be liable for disqualification with the period of disqualification being at the absolute discretion of the Maleny Show Society.
8. **WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT:** Any exhibitor intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Electrical Safety Regulations 2005 Part 5, Division 5. The act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Maleny Showgrounds.
9. All exhibitors or representatives to assemble in the main ring prior to judging on Friday 1st and Saturday 2nd June, 2018.
10. Please bring own feed and water containers
11. Exhibitors making false entries or giving false pedigrees for animals shall forfeit all prizes won at the show
12. **All entries to be registered with a recognised Stud Society, beef or dual purpose.** No exceptions. Proof to accompany your entry.

Please note: the use of grooming blowers is not permitted at times of Judges and Stewards using the microphone, or as directed by the Stewards.
