Collection of entries: Sunday 2 June from 9:30am to 11:30am | Stewards cannot be held responsible for entries not collected by 11:30am. Exhibitors must not remove their exhibits before seeing the Stewards.
Entry Fee: \$1.00
Prize Money: 1st \$10; 2nd \$6; 3rd \$4 (2nd & 3rd only if more than 2 or 3 entries respectively). Prize money must be collected on show days, Fri 31 May & Sat 1 June from the Show Secretary's Office.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

- Exhibits in all classes must be the work of the exhibitor.
- No work allowed to compete in more than one class.
- Judge need not award prizes in any Class in which the exhibits are considered to be of insufficient merit.
- Residence of exhibitors under 18 years of age to be defined as residence of parents.
- Exhibitors may sell goods on commission basis of 15% to the Maleny Show Society.
- Exhibitors are asked to stipulate their own price and attach readable price tags to the exhibits for sale.
- Entries exhibited in previous Maleny Agricultural Show will be ineligible.
- Items must have been completed in the last two years.
- Please NOTE every care will be taken of entries but no responsibility for loss or damage can be accepted.

WOOL NB. All wool to be washed free of grease.

1. Best hank of homespun wool- fine 2 ply-plied
2. Best hank of homespun wool- prepared silver plied
3. Best hank of homespun wool-beginners/first entry plied
4. Best hank of homespun wool-home dyed plied
5. Best hank of homespun- mohair or alpaca or silk
6. Best hank of homespun novelty yarn
7. Best hank of homespun- any fibre or mix
8. Knitted or crocheted item from handspun yarn

FELTING

9. Needle felting
10. Nuno Felting
11. Wet Felting

WEAVING-HAND WOVEN

12. Woven garment/article all in homespun
13. Woven garment/article in any fibre

POTTERY

14. Hand built under 50cm high
15. Pottery featuring surface decoration under 50cm high
16. Thrown on wheel under 50cm high
17. Figurative or animal sculpture under 50cm high

CHINA PAINTING

18. Traditional design

GLASS

24. Fused flat piece-can be full, contour or tac fused, not to exceed 30x30cm
25. Fused and slumped piece-a piece fused and then slumped in a mould, not to exceed 30x30cm
26. Draped piece- a piece draped over a mould or fibre board, not to exceed 30x30cm
27. Fused glass jewellery- broach, bangle or pendant, does not need to be strung

MOSIAC

28. Piece of glass mosaic- not to exceed 30x30cm, weighing less than 15kg.
29. Piece of mosaic from any other or mixed mediums, such as tiles, china, stones, shells etc. must not exceed 30x30cm and weigh less than 15kg.

JEWELLERY

30. Item using hand-made glass components
31. Item using hand-made polymer clay components
32. Item using hand-made beads, any other material
33. Item using purchased components or beads
34. Jewellery set, necklace and earrings, using purchased or hand-made beads

MINIATURE SECTION Items to be no more than 7cm high

35. Item of pottery
36. Item of glass
37. Item using two or more materials, i.e. clay & glass
38. Item of china painting

MISCELLANEOUS

39. Soft toy, includes cloth and character doll
40. Article of heirloom sewing/embroidery
41. Decorative bag/clutch purse etc.
