WOODWORK CLASSES/CATEGORIES

OPEN CLASS

- 2501. Woodturning, bowl or platter
- 2502. Woodturning, spindle or combination spindle and faceplate
- 2503. An article with Pyrography- (wood burning art)
- 2504. Clock - turned or handcrafted (mostly of wood)
- 2505. Wood crafted boxes
- 2506. Wood carving
- 2507. Restored article or an article made from recycled timber
- 2508. Toy making
- 2509. Any article predominantly made of wood (Size of entries will be limited at the discretion of the Stewards. Please phone the Steward if you are unsure).
- 2510. Any article made from a timber burl, can be turned, carved or whatever.

JUNIOR CLASS

- 2511. Clock, turned or hand crafted (mostly of wood)
- 2512. Wood crafted boxes
- 2513. Wood turning (any turned article)
- 2514. Toy making
- 2515. Any article predominantly made of wood
