Entry Fee: \$1.00 | **Prize Money:** 1st \$10; *2nd \$6; *3rd \$4 (Please note prize cards will be awarded, however 2nd and 3rd prize moneypaid only if more than 3 or 4 entries respectively). Prize money must be collected on show days, Fri 28 May & Sat 29 May from the Show Secretary's Office, 9am – 5pm.

Champion Quilt will attract a \$30 special prize – *Donated by Monica Skerman*. Please note that the Quilt judged to be the **Champion of the Show** is eligible for entry into the Quilts Across Queensland Competition as part of the Brisbane Exhibition.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

- Please NOTE every care will be taken of entries but no responsibility for loss or damage can be accepted.
- **All entries must be presented with a rod pocket on the back for hanging purposes.**
- Judge need not award prizes in any Class in which the exhibits are considered to be of insufficient merit.
- Exhibits in all classes must be the work of the exhibitor.
- No work allowed to compete in more than one class.
- Residence of exhibitors under 18 years of age to be defined as residence of parents.
- Exhibitors may sell goods on commission basis of 15% to the Maleny Show Society.
- Exhibitors are asked to stipulate their own price and attach readable price tags to the exhibits for sale.
- Entries exhibited in previous Maleny Agricultural Show will be ineligible.
- Items must have been completed in the last two years.
