EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

- This woodwork section is intended for persons who are not currently professional furniture makers, etc.
- Entries must be original work of the entrant (or joint entrants).
- Judge need not award prizes in any Class in which the exhibits are considered to be of insufficient merit.
- Exhibitors may sell goods on commission basis of 15% to the Maleny Show Society.
- Exhibitors are asked to stipulate their own price and attach readable price tags to the exhibits for sale.
- Residence of exhibitors under 18 years of age to be defined as residence of parents.
- Entries must not have won a prize at any other competition.
- Each entry may not compete in more than one Class.
- All items must have been completed in the last 12 months.
- Entries exhibited in previous Maleny Agricultural Show will be ineligible.
- Please NOTE every care will be taken of entries but no responsibility for loss or damage can be accepted.
- **Size of entries will be limited at the discretion of the Stewards. Please contact the Steward for information.**

WOODWORK CLASSES/CATEGORIES

OPEN CLASS

- 2301. Woodturning, bowl or platter
- 2302. Woodturning, spindle or combination spindle and faceplate
- 2303. An article with Pyrography– (wood burning art)
- 2304. Clock – turned or handcrafted (mostly of wood)
- 2305. Wood crafted boxes
- 2306. Wood carving
- 2307. Restored article or an article made from recycled timber
- 2308. Toy making
- 2309. Any article predominantly made of wood (Size of entries will be limited at the discretion of the Stewards. Please phone the Steward if you are unsure).
- 2310. Any article made from a timber burl, can be turned, carved or whatever.

JUNIOR CLASS

- 2311. Clock, turned or hand crafted (mostly of wood)
- 2312. Wood crafted boxes
- 2313. Wood turning (any turned article)

- 2315. Any article predominantly made of wood
