Collection of entries: Sunday 29 May from 9:30am to 11:30am | Stewards cannot be held responsible for entries not collected by 11:30am. Exhibitors must not remove their exhibits before seeing the Stewards.

Entry Fee: \$2.00 **Junior Entre Fee:** Free

Prize Money: 1st \$10; 2nd \$6; 3rd \$4 (2nd & 3rd only if more than 2 or 3 entries respectively).

Junior Prize Money: 1st \$6, 2nd \$4, 3rd \$2

Prize money must be collected on show days, Fri 27 & Sat 28 May from the Show Office during office hours.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

- Exhibits in all classes must be the work of the exhibitor. *No work allowed to compete in more than one class.
- Judge need not award prizes in any Class in which the exhibits are considered to be of insufficient merit. *Residence of exhibitors under 18 years of age to be defined as residence of parents.
- Exhibitors may sell goods on commission basis of 15% to the Maleny Show Society. *Exhibitors are asked to stipulate their own price and attach readable price tags to the exhibits for sale. *Entries exhibited in previous Maleny Agricultural Show will be ineligible. *Items must have been completed in the last two years.
- Please NOTE every care will be taken of entries but no responsibility for loss or damage can be accepted.

CLASSES/CATEGORIES:

WOOL NB. All wool to be washed free of grease.

- 2801. Best hank of homespun wool- fine 2 ply-plyed
- 2802. Best hank of homespun wool- prepared silver plyed
- 2803. Best hank of homespun novelty yarn
- 2804. Best hank of homespun- any fibre or mix
- 2805. Knitted or crocheted item from hand spun yarn

FELTING

- 2806. Piece of felting

WEAVING-HAND WOVEN

- 2807. Woven garment/article all in homespun
- 2808. Woven garment/article in any fibre

POTTERY

- 2809. Hand built under 50cm high
- 2810. Pottery featuring surface decoration under 50cm high
- 2811. Thrown on wheel under 50cm high
- 2812. Figurative or animal sculpture under 50cm high

CHINA PAINTING

- 2813. Traditional design
- 2814. Modern design

GLASS

- 2815. Fused flat piece-can be full, contour or tac fused, not to exceed 30x30cm
- 2816. Fused and slumped piece-a piece fused and then slumped in a mould, not to exceed 30x30cm
- 2817. Draped piece- a piece draped over a mould or fibre board
- 2818. Fused glass jewellery- broach, bangle or pendant, does not need to be strung

MOSIAC

- 2819. Piece of glass mosaic- less than 15kg.

JEWELLERY

- 2820. Item using hand-made components
- 2821. Item using hand-made and/or purchased components
- 2822. Jewellery set, necklace and earrings, using hand-made and/or purchased components

MISCELLANEOUS

- 2823. Soft toy, includes cloth and character doll
- 2824. Article of heirloom sewing/embroidery
- 2825. Christmas decoration
- 2826. Set of 4 hand-made cards
