Entry Fee: \$2.00 | Junior Entry: Free. Age must be stated on entry form

Prize Money: 1st \$10; *2nd \$6; *3rd \$4

(*Please note 2nd and 3rd prize money paid only if more than
3 or 4 entries respectively)

Junior Prize Money: 1st \$6; 2nd \$4; 3rd \$2

Prize money must be collected on show days, Fri 2nd & Sat 3rd May from the Show Office.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

- Exhibits in all classes must be the work of the exhibitor.
- No work allowed to compete in more than one class.
- Judge need not award prizes in any Class in which the exhibits are considered to be of insufficient merit.
- Residence of exhibitors under 18 years of age to be defined as residence of parents.
- Exhibitors may sell goods on commission basis of 15% to the Maleny Show Society.
- Exhibitors are asked to stipulate their own price and attach readable price tags to the exhibits for sale.
