EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

ÿ This woodwork section is intended for persons who are not currently professional furniture makers, etc.

ÿ Entries must be original work of the entrant (or joint entrants).

ÿ Judge need not award prizes in any Class in which the exhibits are considered to be of insufficient merit.

- ÿ Exhibitors may sell goods on commission basis of 15% to the Maleny Show Society.
- ÿ Exhibitors are asked to stipulate their own price and attach readable price tags to the exhibits for sale.
- ÿ Residence of exhibitors under 18 years of age to be defined as residence of parents.
 - ÿ Entries must not have won a prize at any other competition.
 - ÿ Each entry may not compete in more than one Class.
 - ÿ All items must have been completed in the last 12 months.
- ÿ Entries exhibited in previous Maleny Agricultural Show will be ineligible.
- ÿ Please NOTE every care will be taken of entries but no responsibility for loss or damage can be accepted.
- ÿ Size of entries will be limited at the discretion of the Stewards. Please contact the Steward for information.
