HOW TO ENTER:

All entries must be registered with a recognised Stud Society, beef or dual purpose, and a copy of your registration must accompany your entry forms.

To enter your livestock you are required to **complete and submit TWO FORMS, as well as submit a copy of your registration certificate.** For entry to be valid you will need:

- 1. Livestock Entry form and payment
- 2. Waiver, Release and Acknowledgement form
- 3. A copy of your Registration Certificate for each entry

On arrival at the showgrounds, you will be required to submit the following **PRIOR** to unloading cattle:

2. **Waybill** (please note that you need your own copy for your return journey)

ENTRY RULES: See also General Rules & Regulations within this Show schedule or online.

- All entries and payments to be received by Thurs 18 May 2023. Entry forms and Waivers supplied within this Showbook in the "Forms" section form part of your entry. Forms also available from: www.malenyshowsociety.org.au)
- No exhibits will be permitted to the grounds unless thoroughly tractable. Stewards have discretionary powers to withdraw an exhibit felt to be not well controlled.
- 3. All bulls over 12 months must be led with a nose ring lead/grip. No exceptions.
- 4. Determination of age will be based on age as at 1st May 2023.
- 5. All winning exhibits must be led in the Grand Parade. Failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- 6. There will be **NO** on-ground dipping facilities available.
- 7. WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT: Any exhibitor intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with earth leakage circuit breakers and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of all exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of the Electrical Safety Regulations 2005 Part 5, Division 5. The act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its

provisions. Any exhibitors who do not comply will not be allowed to exhibit at the Maleny Showgrounds.
